Dear pigeon fancier,

We are proud to announce this auction from one of the most renowned pigeon lofts worldwide. Hok Van de Wouwer will no longer be racing pigeons. Combining pigeon racing with a full-time job was no longer feasible, despite his son Kurt's involvement in the last couple of years. And father Gaston has had enough as well. They have made up their minds and the curtain is soon about to fall. "De Kaasboer" has become a household name for pigeon fanciers, it is one of those truly unique pigeons, in the same category as "Bliksem" of Gaby Vandenabeele or "Harry" of Jan Hooymans.

However, Gaston has never had a large collection of breeding birds and he did not sell a lot of birds either. But you could tell that pretty much every fancier who obtained pigeons from him was very successful with them. It reminds me in a way of Ludo Claessens: a small-scale pigeon loft with few pigeons, carefully picked, and with a very high success rate in other lofts. Almost every fancier who invested in pigeons of Van de Wouwer has been very satisfied with them. And surprisingly enough,

Kaasboer features in the pedigrees of many ace pigeons and national winners, even though only a limited number of descendants have ever hit the market.

If you talk to Chinese fanciers about Gaston van de Wouwer, or if you visit him with a group of Chinese or foreign fanciers, they think of him like some sort of god. And when you ask Chinese fanciers about the most popular pigeons on the market, their answer is always

the same: “the pigeons of Gaston van de Wouwer.” I happen to be very fond of his pigeons as well. I still vividly remember Sebastien Casaert winning the title of 1st National Ace Pigeon middle distance in 2011 with a pigeon from a hen of Gaston van de Wouwer. A few years later, he won another title of 1st National Ace Pigeon middle distance, bred from that same hen.

He won that first title with “Amalia”, while the second title went to “Nikolaas”. In other words, he claimed Belgium’s most prestigious title twice in just a few years’ time with two different birds bred from the same dam. That was quite amazing to me.

This was also the big breakthrough moment for him, although many insiders had already been aware of his potential. I remember visiting the late Jos Engels about 15 or 16 years ago. He would be talking about a very strong racing loft from around the area, and that happened to be the loft of Gaston van de Wouwer. To be fair, I had not heard of this loft at the time.

But I remember Jos Engels telling me: “Nikolaas, you will be hearing a lot from him.” And he was right.

He is not a one trick pony either, since Gaston has been able to win a prestigious national victory or ace pigeon title every single season, and so have many other fanciers with his pigeons. These birds have been winning

one or more prestigious titles in China every season as well, which still is the Mecca of one loft racing. Our auction house is honoured that the most famous and most acclaimed pigeon fancier of his generation has again agreed to auction his pigeon collection on PIPA. Gaston, Maria and Kurt are very down to earth, they are affable and they have always remain-

ed modest, despite their many successes. We consider it a sign of appreciation that they decided to go with us, putting their trust in our hands. Gaston, Maria and Kurt, we thank you for your confidence. We will do everything possible to give you the goodbye you deserve after such a fantastic pigeon racing career.

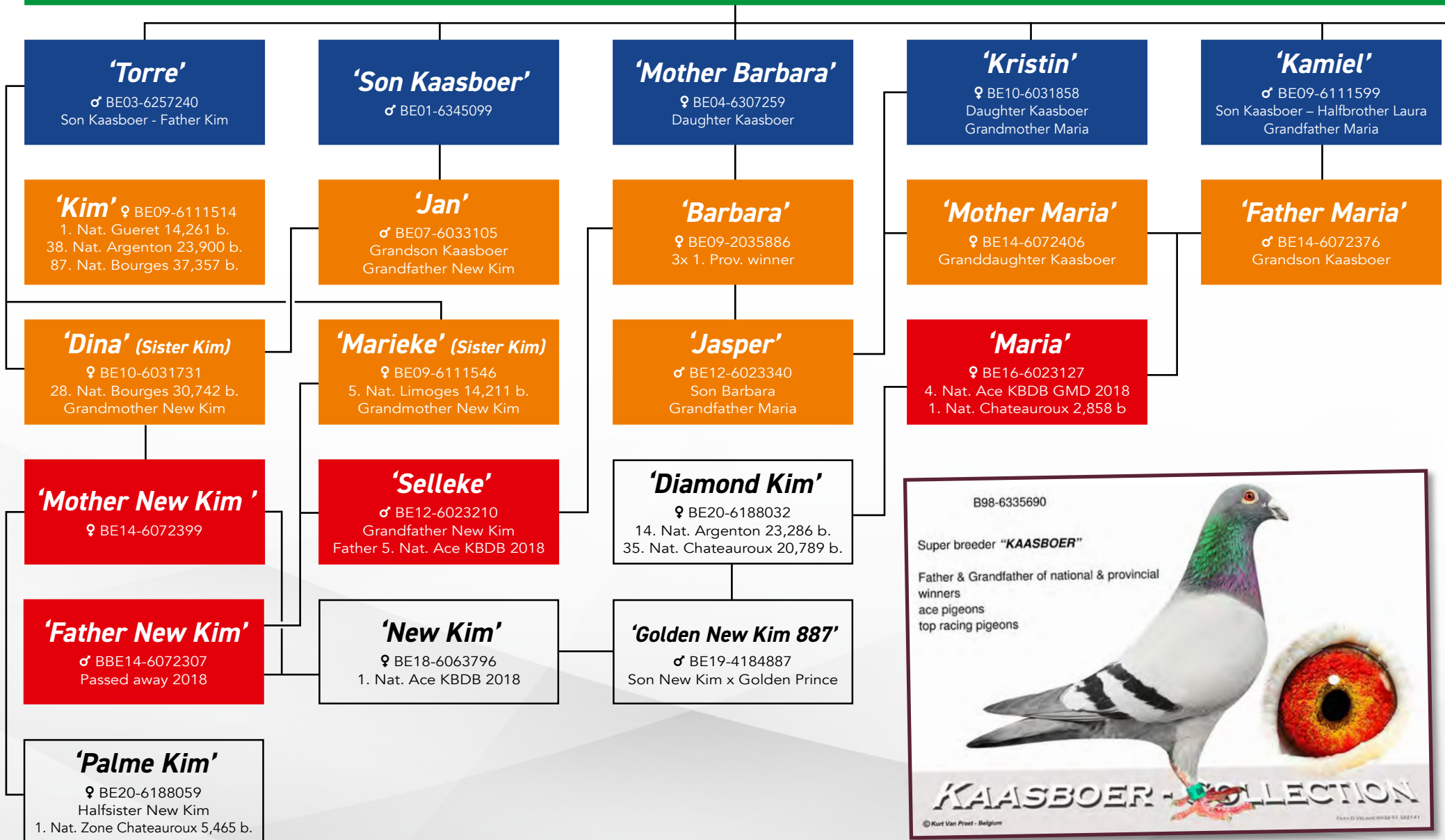


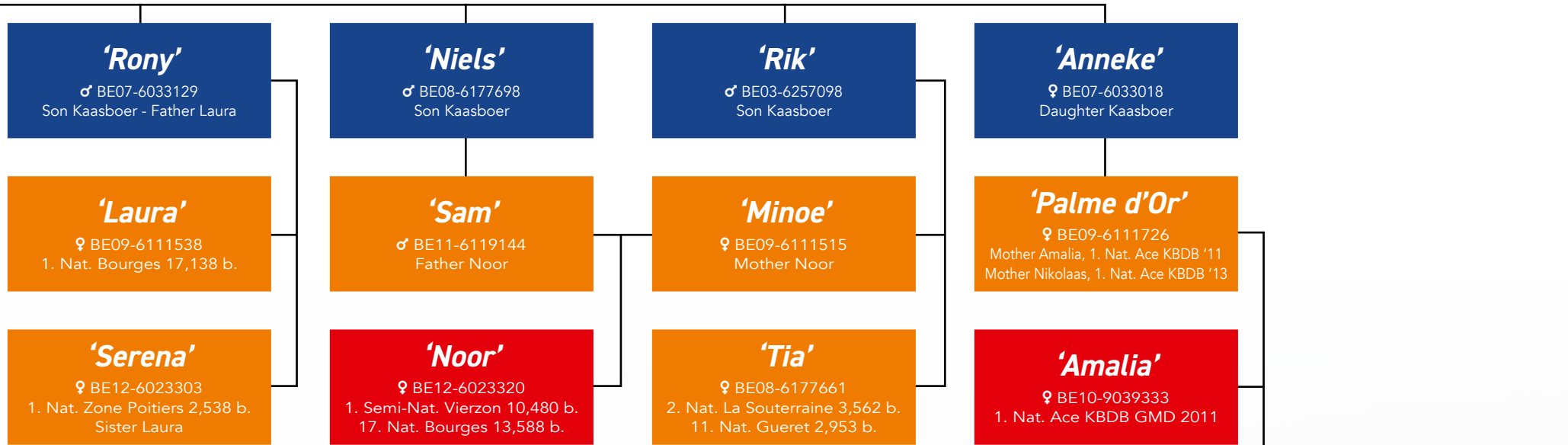

The Van De Wouwer era; THE END OF AN ERA THAT CHANGED THE SPORT

Big news in international pigeon racing; at the very best the Van De Wouwer family can be, the entire colony will be auctioned in PIPA's 20th anniversary year. Including the phenomenal 1st Nat. acebird KBDB 'New Kim' ... including 1st Nat. Chateauroux winner and 4th Nat. acebird KBDB 'Maria'... including all the other current top racers, proven breeders. In other words, this is the legacy of the world famous 'Kaasboer'; an iconic bird of Van De Wouwer and perhaps the most successful ancestor of national race winners and ace pigeons in the modern pigeon era.

After reducing his colony in 2014, Gaston searched for the right formula in pigeon racing. Gaston had just turned 70 and he felt the daily care of the pigeons was a heavy burden. In 2019, when Gaston was hospitalised several times, his son Kurt came to the rescue and he was eager to succeed his father. He managed the colony and Gaston supported him where he could, providing advice and doing some of the daily caretaking. In 2019 and 2020 however, Kurt learned that a busy job and a young family are not the right setting for an individual to be successful in modern-day pigeon racing. "It made Kurt's decision to sell the entire colony not even that hard," says Gaston.

"After almost 65 years as a pigeon fancier, I had already decided it was enough. Maria and I will have more time to enjoy life and to visit all the friend we made thanks to pigeon racing. I am very proud that so many fanciers have succeeded with my pigeons; that is always the greatest compliment a pigeon fanciers can receive."

My life as a fancier has been fantastic," is Gaston's quick conclusion. Born in 1944 as son of a pigeon fancier, it was no wonder he eventually developed a passion for pigeons. He started



running his first own loft at the age of 16, and like many great champions Gaston was a stubborn boy. His ideas about keeping pigeons were different from others. He also translated his experience as a diamond cutter to pigeon racing: you have to handle your valuables with great care and attention. This approach worked out fine for the young Gaston, who raced with youngsters in short distance races at the time.

“Quievrain and Noyon. However, life has so many temptations for a teenager, it would be stupid to put all your energy in pigeons. I enjoyed life in the Sixties, the period in which I met my future wife Maria. Once we got settled, my life as real pigeon fancier began.”

In these early Seventies Gaston paved the road to successes in pigeon racing. He did so by bringing in pigeons very selectively and it was at this point that his “golden feel” for good pigeons arose.

Pigeons from Emanuel Lambrechts (brother of the famous Cyriel) were crossbred with the ‘grey cannons’ of neighbour Stan Gooyvaerts and top class pigeons from Quievrain-specialist Louis Molle. The game was on for Gaston Van De Wouwer. “I have always had good pigeons in my loft,” Gaston explains. “The first impression I have

from a pigeon tells me if I want it or not. A good pigeon must not be too big or too heavy and its head has to express energy. Pigeons have to be ‘of one piece’. That’s what I was searching for but it was hard to find these days. When I bred a group of pigeons that met my requirements, I would promptly see my results improve.”

Gaston looks back to these days with joy. “I am a gambler and like to bet money on my pigeons. I was already used to racing with a limited number of birds of great potential. My pigeons won a lot of Belgian francs. I remember the fair-races in September and October, for which I always prepared some pigeons. I won 120,000 BFR in just two weeks’ time with a 1st and 2nd prize, which was very exceptional those days.” When they got married Gaston promised Maria that his pigeons

would become self-supportive. Winning money achieved that for a big part, for the other part Gaston took youngsters from his best to the market in Lier. After a few years, many fanciers started asking for Gaston’s pigeons, especially fanciers from Germany; they appeared to have great success with Gaston’s pigeons. His star was rising thanks to an increasing number of fantastic results and references.

» **The (inter)national breakthrough**

Bringing in the super pigeon 'Kaasboer' via Jozef and Frans Goovaerts, was like bringing Messi to Barcelona or Ronaldo to Real Madrid ... it meant the beginning of a glorious period. First of all for the maestro himself, of course, who claimed a first national championship title KBDB for the first time in 2004. Despite basketing only a handful of birds, Gaston won several national and provincial top places with the 'Kaasboer' descendants in the years to follow. His most notable results are of course the national victories of 'Kim' (1st Nat. Gueret 2009) and 'Laura' (1st Nat. Bourges 2010) and the titles of 1st Nat. young ace Cureghem Center 2009 and 1st Nat. championship youngsters KBDB 2007. After the auction on PIPA in 2014 the same solid base delivered champions as 'New Kim' (1st Nat. acebird great middle distance KBDB '18) and 'Maria' (1st Nat. Cha-teauroux and 4th Nat. acebird KBDB great middle distance 2018). Besides the many more highlights with 'Kaasboer', offspring also came via other pigeon fanciers. In fact, we reckon no other breeder in the world has produced so many National winners in so many generations.

Well-known fanciers desperately needed these new sensational 'Kaasboer' pigeons and rang at the door in Berlaar ... pigeons were exchanged with Christian Hennes and Dirk Van Dyck pigeons; stars like Johan De Belser, Eddy Janssens, Luc, Bart and Jürgen Geerinckx, Theo Yskout, Frans Rijmenands, Theo Huysegoms came with excellent breeders for co-breeding. Even the international top star Gaby Vandabeele was eager to co-breed with Gaston; it really says all about the status of the Van de Wouwer pigeons.

What really characterises the Van De Wouwer pigeons is their ability to excel in real 'pigeon weather'. They often claim victory with a comfortable lead in races with speeds

of around 1100 mpm. Gaston: "They are not that big, built of one piece and very bright. Natural health is very important to me as well. I never supply medicines preventively, and I reduce the use of antibiotics to a minimum. Therefore their natural resistance is very good. I do not breed many 'bad ones'; that is a matter of selection. And I was of course very lucky to have such a wonderful breeder in my loft that breeds race winners generation after generation: 'Kaasboer'. His breeding potential is enormous, that is the strength of my pigeons."

› The last lustrum - ? -

Shortly before the auction of all old birds on PIPA in 2014, Gaston had already switched to racing hens in widowhood. "I saw hens beginning to dominate the nationals in particular and I have always followed developments in modern-day pigeon racing," says Gaston. For instance: Gaston used to pair young cocks to old hens to keep them motivated already in 1982. After his 2014 auction, Van de Wouwer continued to rely on a breeding team packed with youngsters of his best bird, a total of 24 breeding pairs. Again, famous fanciers showed their interest, which led to co-breedings, for example with Freddy and Jacques Vandenneede. It brought them national winners with Van De Wouwer blood. And Van de Wouwe also agreed to colla-

Generosity paved the road to fame

In the last decade of the previous millennium, many Van De Wouwer pigeons were sold at the market in Lier, mainly to fanciers from the EU. "Looking back, this was a great way to test my pigeons in several lofts," Gaston says. "Because I did not hold back on my pigeons; I took youngsters from all my best breeders to Lier. And many of the buyers contacted me to tell me about their good results." It was already a first indication of their potential...

In later years, when income from the Lier market was not an issue anymore, Gaston still donated several vouchers to clubs asking for it. "And the buyers of these vouchers could always pick their own youngsters. As such, I always gave away pigeons from my best bloodlines ... I would even give away youngsters from 'De Kaasboer' in exchange for these vouchers. I believe that, by giving fanciers the best I have, they were able to achieve so many great results. Even in recent years, when we only had racing birds in our pigeon lofts and we no longer sold pigeons from our breeders, fanciers could pick what they like.

The only pigeons that are allowed to leave our loft are pigeons which I am 100% convinced about. I do not settle for anything less."

The typical Van De Wouwer pigeon

How does the Van De Wouwer pigeons differ from others? Gaston Van De Wouwer characterizes his pigeon as follows:

- Not too big or too heavy ... well balanced at all time;
- A smart head, the pigeon must be very alive;
- A pigeon in one piece; not just plumes;
- Excelling in hard conditions; head winds and hot weather;
- Capable of winning 1100/1200 mpm races with a considerable lead;
- Breeding generations of winners.

Gaston's pigeon mostly excel in the middle and great middle distance, up to 550 km. "However, every year I prepare one or two pigeons for long distance races too, for the Fondclub Antwerp. And they really do very well; they did superbly well in this year's race from Limoges over 680km - so they can clearly perform well across a wide range of distances.

borate with Van Eynde-Govaerts and again with Gaby Vandena-beele ('Rudy' x 2 VD Wouwer hens). He also co-bred pigeons with Nikolaas Gyselbrecht, involving the best birds of the PIPA Elite Center. Kurt: "It was Nikolaas's dream to bring together the best Belgian bloodlines in his breeding loft. We are very proud that our best pigeons are considered to be among Belgium's best."

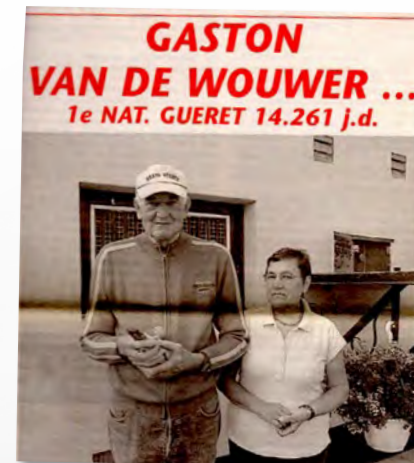

his pigeon racing career. We can say we stop at the top of our career, and we have achieved pretty much everything with the national victory of 'Maria' and the national acebird title of 'New Kim'. I am at peace with my decision, even if that means the end of the Van De Wouwer era in pigeon racing."

In auction on PIPA all racers, breeders, youngsters of Hok Van De Wouwer - all the bad ones were have already been left out. "Not a single pigeon remains," says Gaston. "But I will visit my pigeon friends and watch the pigeons return from the races as they did here. Of course, I will follow the achievements of the pigeons that originate from our lofts in particular; I will be filled with joy every time a pigeon with Van De Wouwer blood wins a major race. I am sure the buyers in this auction will push their pigeon family to new heights with the products of our life's work."



The offspring of the new breeding team was raced and it was Gaston who pushed them to new heights. Of course he did. "However, with every year that went by I was feeling less and less motivated. When the national races came in the middle of the summer I was very fanatic again but there were other moments where it cost me more energy than I wanted. In 2019 I was in hospital four times with pneumonia. For Kurt it was impossible to combine pigeons with his job and family ... and of course these two are more important. He really gave it a serious try, but I very much support his choice not to continue





LOOKING BACK WITH A BIG SMILE

At 76 years of age, Gaston has been a pigeon fancier for almost 65 years. Even though Gaston has become a world famous fancier in recent decades, his most precious memories go back to 'the early days', in the Sixties and Seventies. "Everybody was racing pigeons than," Gaston smiles. "Every street had at least a few pigeon lofts. The short distance was than 'the main course' and you could win a lot of money in these races. Pigeon racing was more relaxed and more about fun and having a good time."

"The charm of the later decades is of course the tension that builds towards Nationals ... the element of 'winning' was on my mind a lot more. Because I was successful and well known across the world, Maria and I could travel for example to China and were often invited on pigeon events or trips. We got to meet many nice people and made new friends. We're also very grateful for that possibility. However, becoming famous also means many visits at our house, many phone calls, etc. At our age we also need more rest. With no pigeons left at all I am sure we will get that now."

'DE KAASBOER'; SOURCE OF NATIONAL VICTORIES

Probably no other pigeon than 'De Kaasboer' of Gaston Van De Wouwer produced so many National winners in so many generations ... the history of a phenomenon.

One year before Gaston Van De Wouwer switched from short distance to middle distance, a cock with ring number BE98-6335690 moved to Gaston. He was bred by Jozef and Frans Goovaerts, which were almost unbeatable at the time in the Quievrain and Noyon races ... only a certain Gaston Van De Wouwer beat them on occasions. The fanciers decided to exchange pigeons and as JozefGoovaerts made a living as salesman in butter, cheese and eggs, the '690' was named after its breeder; 'De Kaasboer', Dutch for cheese-maker.

In his first years as a breeder, 'De Kaasboer' was paired to a beautiful hen from Bart Henderickx, a 16-years old ambitious fancier who did quite well in Noyon with a/o pigeons of Gaston. Circumstances forced Bart to quit pigeon racing and he gave some of his finest hens to Gaston, on the condition that if he would start again, he could get fresh bloodlines from the Van De Wouwer loft. From the pairing 'Kaasboer' x 'Henderickx-duivin' many top racers and breeders were bred, like

- 'Torre Son Kaasboer' 240/03, father of 1st Nat. Gueret 14,245 b. ('Kim'), 1st prov. Montlucon 1.913 b. ('Montlucon'), breeder of 1st Nat. Argenton 30,690 b. at Cleirbait-Desbuquois. Double g.grandfather of 'New Kim' (1st Nat. acebird KBDB 2018)
- 'Rik Son Kaasboer' 098/03, father of 'Tia' (2nd Nat. La Souterraine & 2nd prov. Montlucon) & g.father 'Noor' (1st s-Nat. Vierzon & fastest 15,359 b.), 'Gaston' (Olympiad bird at Uwe Berg), 'Jetje' (1st prov. La Souterraine), etc.

In later years 'De Kaasboer' was paired to many other hens resulting in more victories, including national first places. Another famous partner for 'De Kaasboer' was the original Geerinckx hen BE08-6259169, together they bred a/o 'Kamiel', grandfather of 'Sandra', 1st Nat. Chateauroux 2,855 b., 4th Nat. La Souterraine 16,613 b., etc. & father 'Ester', 6th Belgian youngster PIPA Rankings 2013 ... The pairing 'Rony Son Kaasboer' x 'Geerinckx 169' are a/o parents of the toppers:

- 'Laura', 1st Nat. Bourges & fastest 39,577 b. 2010
- 'Serena', 1st Nat. Zone Poitiers 2,538 b. 2013

'De Kaasboer' x BE04-6307210 are the parents of 'Rony', as mentioned above the breeder of 'Laura'... but they are also g.parents of 'Palme D'Or', at Casaert-Sénéchal breeder of a/o

- 'Amalia', 1st Nat acebird great MD. KBDB 2011
- 'Nikolaas', 1st Nat acebird great MD. old KBDB 2013

Over the course of his career, 'De Kaasboer' has been paired to about 5 or 6 hens and he bred race winners in the first and further generations with each one of them. At the age of 10, 'De Kaasboer' died in the hands of Gaston. This pigeon, that helped Hok Van De Wouwer gain the status it has today, has been embalmed and every night, when Gaston sits in the living room, he looks into the eyes of the finest diamond he has ever owned.

All pigeons in auction – no exceptions!

After this auction of Hok Van De Wouwer, no pigeons will be left over in the lofts of Gaston and Kurt Van De Wouwer. So why not call this a 'total sale'? Gaston explains: "I very much look forward to the time without pigeons ... where Maria and I can do everything we want without obligations towards pigeons. However I have had pigeons all my life; I cannot guarantee I won't miss them. If I ever restart, it will not happen before 2022, and not with my own pigeons, so I will never make "Van de Wouwer" pedigrees again. If this sale would be called a 'total auction', the KBDB would forbid me to race pigeons for the next 2 years. I don't want that restriction."

1. NATIONAL ACEBIRD GREAT MIDDLE DIST. YB KBDB 2018

We go back to Saturday September 15th, in the backyard of Melkouwen 8 in Berlaar. Tension is rising in the garden of Gaston Van De Wouwer as this could be the day 'New Kim' seizes power over the Belgian skies and goes for the 1st National acebird title with youngsters in the KBDB great middle distance category. Journalists came over trying to get a scoop and among the guests were Nikolaas Gyselbrecht and Kai Er, one of China's most famous fancier and crazy about the super class Van de Wouwer pigeons. They would not want to miss this potentially unforgettable day for Gaston.

'New Kim' had opened her quest for gold as youngster with a 2nd Nat. Chateauroux on August 18th, followed by a 12th Nat. Argenton on September 3rd and a 52nd prov. Blois on September 8th. Apparently the longer distances and the harder races brought out the best in this top class hen, inbred to 1st National winner 'Kim'. She needed four top prizes for the title of 1st National acebird so the National race from Chateauroux, the last of the season, was pretty much the one and only chance for eternal fame. Tension rose as the first pigeons were clocked for the shorter distance and soon all spectators knew; 6 and a half hours of racing should be sufficient to bring in the title.

Pigeons were liberated at 8.30 and the closer it got to 3 o'clock, the noise died down and spectators were focused on the sky. Gaston looked at them from a distance and felt

no pressure ... he was just enjoying what he likes most; waiting for his pigeons to arrive home from a National race. Tension was high as a blue hen arrived home like a rocket and Gaston walked towards the loft to check the clocking time. Spectators were holding their breath; was it 'New Kim'?

The colour gave nothing away, as Gaston had entered 12 pigeons and all 12 were blue hens. He checked the clock, took the control gummi from the pigeon's paw and slowly turned around to the crowd and put his thumb up ... like an emperor who expresses his approval towards a gladiator. And just like in the Roman empire ages ago, the arena in Berlaar was filled with applause and people were cheering ... except from the maestro himself - he turned around, put his hands in his pocket and cast his eyes to the sky, waiting for the second pigeon to arrive.

In the summer of 2018 tropical temperatures rampaged Belgium and made the young birds season as one of the most heavy in years. On August 18th the third National Chateauroux race was at stake and at the Van De Wouwer residence tension ran high as Gaston was convinced his team was ready to reap: "In a season as hard as this, my pigeons can really make a difference."

Next to a nice group of youngsters in top condition, Gaston basketed a fine selection of old hens - as always at the end of the season on eggs - including the two year old 'Maria' ... she had already shown her class winning top prizes as youngster, yearling and 2-years old, including a 4th Nat. La Souterraine in 2016. In 2018 she had already won a 51st-117th-120th-163rd National preceding the Chateauroux race ... a top prize would push her to the top 5 National acebirds KBDB. When 'New Kim' was clocked after 6.5 hours of racing, giving her everlasting fame as 1st Nat. acebird KBDB, Gaston's focus was elsewhere - he kept his eyes peeled to the sky, as if he knew that 'Maria' was up for another surprise...

While spectators were busy calculating 'New Kim's speed and her chance of winning the national young birds' race, 'Maria' came tumbling from the sky like a cannon reaching a speed of 1351 mpm over a distance of 523 km. Gaston welcomed her home and winked at her. A little while later 'Maria' was celebrated as 1st National winner Chateauroux from 2,855 old birds, ending a day that Gaston Van De Wouwer WILL treasure forever!

Kim won a 1st national Gueret in 2009 as young bird against over 14,000 pigeons as well as a 38th national Argenton 2009 against 23,900 pigeons an 87th national Bourges 2009 against 37,357 pigeons. She would have won a 1st national ace pigeon title KBDB GMD as well, but at that time there was no such championship yet. And what is even more special: right when we were about to publish this catalogue, the first ever grandchild of “New Kim” that has been bred and raced got ranked 4th best pigeon of Belgium GMD KBDB, with only one more race to go. “New Kim” is not only a super racing pigeon but is also turning out to be a super breeder.
