THE MAGIC OF THE PEN

Famous in pigeon sport is the magazine Duifke Lacht, published by Natural breeding station. The magazine was published all around the world - in many languages. Generations of fanciers grew up with this magazine ... and they grew up with André Roodhooft.

As champion racer and progressive fancier, Jef De Scheemaecker knew for sure a monthly column of André would be of extra value. Since 1976 André accepted the challenge and fanciers were enthusiastic about André's fine way of writing; from the heart and with no taboos or secrets. In fact, for many readers the first thing they did when the magazine came is was looking for the André Roodhooft pages.

André always developed throughout the years and in the Eighties he got his typing diploma and bought himself a typewriter.

Jef De Scheemaeker received the first typed column and looked André deep in the eyes.

"André," he said. "your magic is in your pen.

Please type no columns anymore, do not use the typewriter." Anno 2020 still every column produced by André is handwritten.

ANDRÉ ROODHOOFT

THE CHRONICLE OF A WINNER BY NATURE

He is considered as one of the greatest influencers in International pigeon racing ... mentioned as one of 'the force' behind the success of breeding station Natural ... but above all; one of the greatest champions in Belgian pigeon racing ever!! The record-holding 17(!) times King of Union Antwerpen ... recent winner of 5(!) times 1st National ... and many, many more impressive highlights. Naturally, the auction of all old birds of André Roodhooft on PIPA is beyond every doubt one of the greatest highlights in PIPA's 20th anniversary year.

He smiles modestly when the characterization of great all time champion is mentioned to André Roodhooft. No-nonsense is very much at its place when it concerns the 74 years old Belgian star. Many trophies in his office and a book full of pictures composed by his wife Annette are the silent witnesses of a pigeon life at the top ... a long life and as men get older, their energy level reduces. For André and for his close friend and great pigeon help Roger Bollansee aging limits them in their way of homing pigeons. Together they spend weeks in hospital in 2019 and the first half of 2020. Therefore this is the right moment to take a huge step back and to respond positively to PIPA's request for a spectacular auction. On the eve before the online sensation, PIPA sat down with André and Annette and asked for the history behind the legend of Roodhooft.

■ TOWARDS A SERIOUS PIGEON FANCIER

Shortly after World War II, in 1946, André Roodhooft was born as youngest but one in a family with 7 child-

ren in total. Two of his older brothers (the oldest is 23 years older than André) and a brother in law were pigeons fanciers and in his love for all that lives, André's interest was slowly triggered more and more towards racing pigeons. At the age of 7 he got his first youngsters, naturally from his family members. A small section of the chicken-loft was transformed into pigeon-loft and the game for André Roodhooft as individual pigeon fancier was on. At the age of 18 already he was amongst the champions of the Quievrainverbond in Geel.

What André did in his first years as fancier, was riding his bike to the pige-on-markets of Lier and Mol and try to buy the 'left-overs' for almost nothing. "Naturally these pigeons were often no good, but listing results was for me than not a real item yet. At the age of 18 I served the army, shortly after I married my first wife





Monique and we raised a family. I became more and more triggered to improve my performances, but in the several jobs I had, there was hardly time for pigeons ... and therefore just room for occasional successes. In the late Sixties however, when my job was a salesman of car-tires, my working hours were much better and I could race my pigeons seriously." And directly André's star rose in short distance racing.

It is also in that period that André was introduced to the hauler Van De Pol to do business. When he mentioned his hobby, mister Van De Pol politely asked André to come to the farm of his father Nelles – also pigeon fancier – and the two spend the rest of the afternoon talking pigeons. Many of these afternoons followed and André and Nelles became close friends. Nelles had fantastic pigeons from Hofkens, Merkplas. A phenomenon in Belgian pigeon sport and really an champion-maker. Hofkens was than what for example Heremans, Van De Wouwer or Vandenabeele is in the present era; a strain of pigeons that excels for many fanciers. André Roodhooft got his Hofkens pigeons via Nelles Van De Pol and until the day of today this family is the base of his colony.

■ The step to Natural

Next to bringing in good pigeons, André also grabbed all opportunities he saw to expend his knowledge in pigeon sport. He followed the poultry school and special Racing Pigeon seminars by the late Dr. Stam from The Netherlands. All attributed to Andre's level in performing, which was superb in short distance racing. He became well-known for his outstanding results. In search for a new loft André went to Noël De Scheemaecker, a very friendly man who invited André to his house. The two talked pigeons and after their conversation Noël said to his wife: 'this man was

raised with pigeon milk'. A fancier also with managing skills; just the man Noël searched to manage his breeding centre.

"That was naturally a great opportunity," André remembers. "I had always said; one day I will make a living with pigeons ... and this was just that change. For a year I drove to Sint Antonius Zoersel each day, than we moved to the breeding centre to live there." André had full responsibility over the breeding team, but for racing he insisted to stay autonomous. He took 20 pigeons from his colony and built a new team, strictly separated from the Natural pigeons. André remained his Hofkens via Nelles Van De Pol base and only very rarely new pigeons are brought in and just a happy few charmed André. Like a direct son of 'Rico' from Houben ... a grandson of 'Den 231' Engels ... a son of 'Di Caprio' from Dirk Van Dyck ... the '500 Hen' of Gebr. Janssen bloodlines via Karel Cuyvers ... and the 'Marseille' lines of Marcel Aelbrechts.

Most success as quality injection came via pigeons of Lou Wouters, also a very close friend. Wouters pigeons were the

only ones decided good enough by André to play a major role in his colony. Hofkens is the solid base, but Wouters was that excellent bloodline to create a winning synergy. André was even such a good friend, that a Lou's death the remaining 13 pigeons went to André ... that was how Lou wanted it.

"I started racing youngsters from the Natural location in 1975 and in 1976. In that period racing for money was the main motive for the majority of the fanciers. Those days my pigeon 'Marieke' created a furore for me. On the race from Orleans as youngster she and her loftmates won 80,000 Belgian Francs, what was really a lot of money.

AIMING FOR PERFECTION

At the age of 14 André left school to help on the farm of his parents. However his eagerness to develop in life drove him to follow many courses and to become an all-round employee in further jobs. For example he now speaks 5 languages fluently. Until the day of today, when new orthography is introduced, André studies it to make sure he can ban out mistakes.

A good example of André's perfectionism goes back to the early Eighties. As manager of Natural Breeding Station he was invited to the Canary Islands, however he spoke only English. Very soon André realised this obstructed communication and when his host said farewell André answered him 'I only return when I speak the language'. And so André went to course, spend his evenings studying Spanish and two years later, invited by the Argentinian board, as first European pigeon fancier he gave a 2 hours speech on the National congress with 500 attendants ... in perfect Spanish.

Together with perfection goes a strong matter of dedication. And that went very far. On the day his daughter got her Holy commune, all friends and relatives came to celebrate. André arranged a nice establishment, however the pigeons were liberated late and had to arrive just when the party was getting started. André offered his daughter a choice; his presence or 500 BFr. And so he was absent for a while to clock his pigeons. "Next to the money it costed me a few angry looks," André now smiles.

My confidence in her was huge. So I convinced my wife to bet 70,000 Francs on the racing team for the National Bourges youngsters race ... Monique could hardly sleep over it, but on the racing day 'Marieke' and the bunch did not let us down and won 590,000 Belgian Francs." The year after, as yearling again 'Marieke' was head of the team that did the job ... again! André bet 80,000 and they brought home 680,000 Belgian Francs. These were record amounts those days ... and above all a great indication of the enormous potential in the strong colony of André Roodhooft.

To become king

In the Eighties and Nineties the name of Roodhooft became world famous. With his contributions to the magazine Duifke Lacht, André became one of the most popular writers in pigeon sport. His articles were read and appreciated all over the world. Many fanciers adore the way he looks upon pigeon sport and André was invited to speak on seminars on all continents. André also kept on performing within the top of Belgian pigeon sport and was the leading force behind Natural breeding station. After 28 years, around 1998, André came to retire at Natural and he moved to Pulderbos with his family.

Impatient with new pigeons

André purchases not more than 2 or 3 pigeons per year to bring new bloodlines in his colony. "New material must be built as close to perfection as possible. I always pair them up to proven pigeons. Likewise I can judge them quickly; if descendants fail only the new breeder can be to blame. I make sure I get at least 6 youngsters, so I can honestly judge the children on young birds performances. When nothing spectacular came from these 6, I remove the new breeder and all of its family ... no matter what it costed me."

A new location asked for new goals and André found them in focussing on the title King of Antwerpen Union. This area had always been considered as the Mecca of International pigeon sport and making this upper class area to his kingdom was an ambitious goal. He managed to already be king in 1983, 1988 and 1992, but knew to win the title special focus on all disciplines were asked for. Consistent pigeons were needed, not missing their prizes and also grabbing top positions with ease ... and that from 300 to 700 km preferably. King of the Union Antwerpen is very much an all-round title and standing a chance on winning it, you need a wide-wise family of very strong pigeons.

What happened the years after is never shown before in Belgium and shall probably never been shown again. Between 2000 and 2015 André Roodhooft was crowned as king 13 times ... add the titles before the millennium change and the latest one in 2019 and he won the dazzling number of 17 times kinghood. It made André definitely one of the best fanciers in Belgian pigeon racing history. With a family of pigeon, really the same as from the Seventies on. With as strong weapon a very strict way of selecting pigeons. Hard but fair with only room for the very best. The best in Antwerpen area, but many believe the very best in the country ...

For André there was only one waterproof way to find it out; by showing skills on the National races.

From Union King to Nationwide ruler

Absolute low in the successful pigeon are was the death of Monique. Naturally André was devastated, but he found comfort in his pigeons and since 2010 his new partner Anette moved in and she brings joy in André's daily life. In 2012 André got the taste for the Nationals winning the 1st National old birds on Gueret, the last race of the season. Not his main goal, but when André experienced the impact this victory had – he knew his aim for the years to come. Winning against the total nation ... beating all these fanciers that work day in day out to bring their favourites in pole position to the start. The appreciation winning pigeons get after such a highlight – it kind of overwhelmed the man who really thought he had seen it all. From that moment on he said 'I will prepare my team for the Nationals now' and what a move this was ...

Naturally it took a little switch in a/o selection criteria. André: 'I now select mostly on the further distances. Youngsters must perform well on races above 300 km and I also needed to change my ways in feeding, make sure they built of plenty



of reserves so recuperation is always very fast. And keep on playing the pigeons week in, week out. Keep them in the flow of racing and always have the partners at home ... Changes in small things, but nobody was surprised also this discipline was bound to be conquered by the Pulderbos patron.

From the siege with 'Gueretje' in 2012 ... to the 1st Nat. La Souterraine young and 1st Nat. La Souterraine old in 2014 ... continuing with 1st Nat. championship and 1st Nat. acebird great middle distance in 2015 ... leading 'Lady Shine' to the 1st Nat. Bourges 2017 ... and coming full circle with 1st Nat. La Souterraine old in 2020. What a success and what a way to end fifty years of pigeon racing at the very top of Belgium. And just the perfect timing to listen to his physical problems and drastically reduce the colony. All old birds are sold on PIPA and just the last youngsters bred from the toppers stay as new breeding team for the years to come, with about 25% of the size of the colony André Roodhooft has now. The end of an era of the one and only King of Antwerpen and showpiece of Belgian pigeonsport.

- the 3 first nominated pigeons on 300-400 km old
- the 3 first nominated pigeons on 300-400 km yearlings
- the 3 first nominated pigeons on 300-400 km young
- the 2 first nominated pigeons on 450-600 km old
- the 2 first nominated pigeons on 450-600 km yearlings
- the 2 first nominated pigeons on 450-600 km young
- the first nominated pigeon on 5 great long distance races And the King becomes the Emperor...

MEETING UP TO THE ROODHOOFT STANDARD

Normally over a hundred youngsters are bred at the Roodhooft lofts ... but not that many make it to the end of the season. André selects from day one and youngsters must convince him they earn a spot in next year's racing team. His 6 benchmarks of judging for quality:

- 1. On the moment of weaning the youngster must look perfect. If not? It is removed.
- 2. Youngsters that do not train well are removed. No matter what pedigree
- 3. On the first toss all pigeons are handled 1 by 1 and given a grade. The lower the grade, the less the patience.
- 4. Youngsters with no prizes after 5 races are removed.
- 5. Youngsters with hardly prizes and no top positions after 8 races are removed.
- 6. At the end of the season youngster must have a good prize percentage with at least 2 top positions ... otherwise they are removed.

At the Roodhooft residence it is often coming and going of fanciers interested in André's advices. On many occasions André and Annette treat their friends to sandwiches from their favourite store in Pulle. On one of these occasions the two employees Sandra and Annick asked for the pigeons and André invited them to have a look. They had a great afternoon and Sandra – daughter of a pigeon fancier – asked if André gave his pigeons names. "Only the very special ones," he answered. To continue with a joke: "My next good racing hen I will call after you."

A while later, after the 2015 season, reporter Gert from De Duif visited André and Annette for a loft report and congratulated them with the 1st Nat. ace KBDB. "How should we call her," Gert asked. André and Annette looked at each other and smiled; "name her Sandra." In the famous newspaper Gazet Van Antwerpen the hen was also presented and Sandra and her father read about it. He walked towards André and asked if the pigeon was called after his daughter, André confirmed. The man got tears in his eyes and directly went to his daughter Sandra to bring the big news.

When Rik Hermans asked me some questions for magazine De Duif, he also mentioned the Olympiad to me and asked me if 'Belgiums Best' would go. When I said I have no clue he was wondered I did not send her results in. But for me it was just a very good pigeon, that is all that matters. Rik asked me if he could send the results in for me; naturally I agreed."

And just like 10 years before the results appeared to be more than enough. André was again Olympiad competitor ... and again his thanks go out to a good friend in pigeon sport.

"André, put this topper on the breeding loft and built a colony around her," he heard several times. But André knew future success would not depend on this hen only. So he

gambled ... and this time he gambled false. With some fine performances she had her share in the title 1st Nat. champion middle long distance old KBDB, but then destiny punished André's recklessness. The super hen never returned from one of the very last races in 2015. What lasts is nothing but memories.
